## Doggie dream house

Your beloved Fido doesn't care if his shelter is cute—what matters to him is size. So take your dog house-hunting and see if there's room for him to stand, turn around, and stretch out in the pad you're considering buying. If he can't, find one that's larger.

To protect your pooch against cold and wet weather, look for a unit that has insulated walls and that can be elevated at least three inches off the ground. Here are three shelters that fit those criteria.

**Drs. Foster & Smith Dogloo** (one style, for small- and medium-size dogs, \$89.99, *shown*) is designed



to trap the body heat of its occupant. **PetsMart Top Paw Doghouse** (three styles, for all dog sizes, \$39.99 and up) is a lightweight, traditional-looking pet shelter.

**Petco Precision Pet Outback** (three styles, for all dog sizes, \$99 and up) is made of fir wood and looks like a rustic log cabin. —Charlotte Reed
